Student Mobility / Placement Announcement

Erasmus+ KA107 or International Credit Mobility (ICM) programme is a fully-funded mobility program that enables exchange of students, teaching and non-teaching staff between Manisa Celal Bayar University and its partners (Higher Education Institutions-HEI or non-HEIs). The project numbered “**2019-1-TR01-KA107-073710**” is for activities must be realized between **01/08/2019 – 31/07/2022**. Erasmus+ International Credit Mobility Program enables exchange of students from **University of Sfax** for study and training/placement mobility activity.

This call opens for applications *only for the department specified in this announcement*.

The budget allocations for outgoing mobilities are summarized in the below table.

Application dates are between **25/10/2021** and **08/11/2021**.

Students will receive a travel support, which is calculated based on the distance between participants' place of residence and place of activity.

Travel grant will be paid before mobility.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- 1) All participants should abide by the allocated budget constraints since no extra funding is available.**
- 2) The travel budget is calculated according to the travel calculator and even if the ticket fare exceeds the travel support amount, no extra funding can be granted to the participants.**

APPLICATIONS, EVALUATION AND SELECTION FOR STUDENTS

a) Student Study Mobility

- 1) The student must have completed at least 2 semesters in the program they are enrolled in. By the last day for application, students who have cumulative grade point average (CGPA) of 12/20 (for undergraduates), 13/20 (for graduates) can apply to the program.**
- 2) For students to receive an ICM grant, they need to spend at least one semester (3 months) in the host university. ICM student mobility grant covers a minimum of 90 days.**
- 3) Students who will participate in mobility programs are obliged to take courses from the host university at least worth 30 ECTS (around 5 courses) or (for graduate students) fulfill the same amount of credits worth of thesis work. In cases where the partner university is not using ECTS evaluation criteria is number of courses. If so, students must pass at least 3/5 of the taken courses. Students who fail to meet these criteria cannot receive the 20% of the total grant.**
- 4) Students who benefited from Erasmus+ study and/or internship programs or other mobility programs offered by the university will receive 10pts penalty in their ICM placement points for each time they took part in a mobility program. For one mobility program 10pts, for two mobility programs 20pts, for three mobility programs 30pts penalty will be applied.**
- 5) Disabled students who can document their disability with a medical report will receive 10 pts.**
- 6) Students must check the language requirements for the partner universities. Host university can demand student's transcript in order to track student's academic status and success, and this can affect the acceptance process. Partner universities may require a language proficiency exam grade document for their language of education. It is not possible for the student to study in a university if they cannot meet the language requirement for the said university. Since language proficiency requirements differ among universities, it is necessary to check the university's website for the language requirements before application and to make sure the language requirements can be fulfilled/documented before the deadline.**

- 7) Participation in Erasmus programme in the country of nationality is subject to a 10pt penalty.
- 8) 80% of the grant is paid before mobility. The remaining 20% is paid upon successful completion of the program which is required to be documented by the student.

- 9) **Evaluation of the applicants:** Cumulative grade point average: **50%**
- Foreign language: **50%**
- Previous participation in Erasmus+ programs (per mobility): **-10pts**
- Disabled students: **+10pts**
- Participation in country of nationality: **-10pts**

b) Student Training Mobility

- 1) During the application the student must have a cumulative grade point average (CGPA) in the program they are enrolled in. Students that are studying in Basic English Department cannot apply to the program due to the fact that they do not have a cumulative grade point average (CGPA). By the last day for application, students who have cumulative grade point average (CGPA) of 12/20 (for undergraduates), 14/20 (for graduates) can apply to the program.
- 2) For students to receive an ICM grant, they need to spend a total of 2 months (60 days) in the host university.
- 3) Students who benefited from Erasmus+ study and/or internship programs or other mobility programs offered by the university will receive 10pts penalty in their ICM placement points for each time they took part in a mobility program. For one mobility program 10pts, for two mobility programs 20pts, for three mobility programs 30pts penalty will be applied.
- 4) Disabled students who can document their disability with a medical report will receive 10pts.
- 5) Participation in Erasmus programme in the country of nationality is subject to a 10pt penalty.
- 6) 80% of the grant is paid before mobility. The remaining 20% is paid upon successful completion of the program which is required to be documented by the student.
- 7) **Evaluation of the applicants:** Cumulative grade point average: **50%**
- Foreign language: **50%**
- Previous participation in Erasmus+ programs (per mobility): **-10pts**
- Disabled students: **+10pts**
- Participation in country of nationality: **-10pts**

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- 1.** Applications should be sent to icm@usf.tn between the dates **25/10/2021** and **08/11/2021** and handed to International Relations Office – University of Sfax Airport Road km 0.5 - Sfax Late applications will not be accepted.
- 2.** All applicants should be able to provide the certification of English proficiency (MCBU English exam, YDS, YOKDIL or exams which are accepted by OSYM) with a minimum of 60 points and cumulative grade point average (CGPA) of 12/20 for undergraduate students and 14/20 for graduate students
- 3.** The application form should be printed, signed and handed to International Relations Office – University of Sfax Airport Road km 0.5 - Sfax with other required documents (Europass CV, Copy of Passport, All Transcript of records, Acknowledgement of enrolment and English Proficiency Document).
- 4.** The application results will be announced on 12/11/2021 through university website.
