Objective

The Erasmus+ Programme – mobility for study offers the possibility to spend a period of teaching at **University of Coimbra** for **Teaching Staff** from The Faculty of Sciences of Sfax

Erasmus+ International Credit Mobility KA107 is a project approved in the framework of Erasmus+ programme, aiming at fostering cooperation in the field of Higher Education between European and partner countries Institutions through a mobility scheme addressing staff exchanges. The current call for applications covers a bilateral mobility between the **UC** as Higher Education Institution in the EU and Higher Education Institutions in partner countries.

In order to apply for a grant within the framework of *Erasmus* + *KA107- ICM* project, candidates must comply with the **following general requirements**:

- They must be official members of their home University, that is:
- Staff must be employed in the Partner Higher Education Institution.

NUMBER AND TYPES OF MOBILITY:

UC Erasmus + *KA107- ICM* project 2020 includes the following **types of mobility** according to the academic level of the candidates:

<u>1 Mobility for :</u>

- Academic Staff

- Academic Staff: academic staff should contact their respective counterpart at the host university in order to accordingly draw up their teaching plan.

DURATION OF THE MOBILITY

- 1 Week : (5 working days + 2 days for travel)

AMOUNT OF GRANTS

The Erasmus+ for study scholarships are contributions to support living costs in the hosting country. The scholarship for Portugal is of $160 \notin$ per day.

A supplementary sum will cover the travel costs on the basis of the distance between Sfax and Coimbra according to the European distance calculator: <u>http://ec.europa.eu/programmes/erasmus-plus/tools/distance_en.htm</u>

- Visa expenses.
