The Competition **I&V-PhD** aims to promote innovation and valorization of scientific research. It is reserved for young researchers whose PhD research project have innovative and entrepreneurial results. This Competition encourages these PhD researchers to showcase aspects as valorization, innovation, and economic impact of their PhD research works. They will have to prepare a 5mn video to show these aspects and clear steps that should be undertaken towards its promotion (e.g., start-up, technology transfer, MOBIDOC, patent, etc.)

#### **DETAILS FOR PARTICIPATION**

To be able to participate in this edition of the competition I&V-PhD, you should:

- ✓ be either a PhD student in the final phase of the thesis, or a new doctor (thesis defended after Jan. 1st, 2021)
- ✓ prepare a poster and a 5mn video as detailed above.

Submissions, in <u>French</u> or <u>English</u>, should be done online using this form: <a href="https://forms.gle/xp9KwmfT9CcL8puSA">https://forms.gle/xp9KwmfT9CcL8puSA</a> Submissions will be peer-reviewed by the scientific committee. Based on the review results, the best proposals will be short-listed. Respective students (15 to 20) will be notified by email and should attend the competition in person to present their project. On the day of the competition, the evaluation will be based on feedback from the scientific committee, professors, and guests from industry.

#### **CERTIFICATES & AWARDS**

- ✓ The students who will submit to this competition will receive Doctoral credits and a participation certificate.
- ✓ The 15-20 short-listed participants will be invited to attend trainings on patent writing & intellectual property.
- ✓ The first 4 winners will receive more extra Doctoral credits, certificates, and cash prizes (TND) as follows:
