Using <u>up to five slides</u> and a period of <u>exactly 180 sec</u>, participants should use simple but concise words to explain their research work to a diverse audience. In addition, they should convince them of its impact on the real world through nowadays hot applications.

- 2) be either a PhD student in the final phase of the thesis, or a new doctor (thesis defended in 2022)

Submissions, in <u>English</u>, should be done using this form <u>PhD3M 2023</u> and will be peer-reviewed by members of the Scientific Committee based on the level of their: **understanding** of the research work **(10)**, and **conviction** of the work importance **(10)**.

Based on review results, the best submissions will be short-listed, and respective students will be notified by email. They should attend in person the one-day contest on 22 February 2023 during the SSD'23 conference. The same evaluation criteria will be used as those for submission. But, during the competition, marks will be collected from the Scientific Committee and audience.
