



Call for Applications

Scholarships to study at the University of Liège (Belgium) in the framework of the European Programme ERASMUS+ KA107

Objective

The University of Liège (Faculté d'Agronomie de Gembloux Agro-Bio Tech) offers the possibility to spend internship mobility for students enrolled at the National School of Engineers (3rd year Food engineering) within the Erasmus+ International Credit Mobility (ICM) Programme.

Mobility students will be awarded a scholarship, will use all the facilities of the **University of Liège** on an equal basis as the enrolled students.

The sending institution commits to recognize the approved credits obtained/research period carried out by students during the mobility period spent at University of Liège as encoded in the approved learning agreement.

Scholarship

The Erasmus+ for study scholarships are contributions to support living costs in the hosting country and will cover the following costs:

- A fixed contribution which varies according to the European Country of destination and the number of days spent at the hosting institution. The scholarship is of 850 € per month (30 days).
- A supplementary sum will cover the travel costs on the basis of the distance between the home town and Liège, according to the European distance calculator http://ec.europa.eu/programmes/erasmus-plus/tools/distance_en.htm

Conditions and Application procedures

General conditions for admittance

The candidate must be enrolled, for the whole duration of the mobility, at the University of Sfax - National School of Engineers (3rd year Food Engineering).

Applications must be submitted to the Sending Institution, that will be in charge of pre-selecting the students and officially communicate the list to ULiège.

Application Procedures

- Internship Proposal signed by the academic tutor at home institution.
- Copy of Passport
- All transcripts of Records (from the BAC)
- Short CV
- Invitation letter from The University of Liège (Faculté d'Agronomie de Gembloux Agro-Bio Tech)

All documents in Arabic should be translated into English language.

The home Institution will be responsible of selection procedures on the basis **transparent and fair criteria**.

Pre-selection criteria at the home university

The home university will provide a pre-selection of candidates according to the following general criteria:

- Average grade.
- The consistency of the proposed research activities.
- Any other elements indicated by the student in the application (other learning experiences, specific academic interests, etc.).

The deadline for applying is fixed on 02 February 2023.
