Objective

The Erasmus+ Programme – mobility offers the possibility to spend a period of teaching at **University of Liège** for 2 **Academic Staff** from the University of Sfax – National School of Engineers of Sfax – Food Engineering Department.

The purpose of the activity is to share experiences in the field of food engineering, and it will take place in the **University of Liège** (Faculté d'Agronomie de Gembloux Agro-Bio Tech) on which participants will discuss the points of common interest.

Financing

Grant amount: 160 € per day.

Travel grant: 275 €

Teaching Mobility:

Based on the budget allocated to the **University of Liège**, it is possible to fund maximum 7 days (included travel days) per participant.

Conditions and procedures:

General conditions for admittance

Applications should be submitted to the home institution that will be responsible for selecting the participants, according to previously established criteria. All fundamental principles and mobility requirements set out in the Inter-Institutional Agreement must be respected. The selection procedure must be fair, transparent, coherent and documented and shall be made available to all parties involved in the selection process
