

## Call for Applications

### Scholarships to study at university of “Dunarea de Jos” University of Galati in the framework of the European Programme ERASMUS+ KA1

#### **OBJECTIVE**

The Erasmus+ Programme – mobility for study offers the possibility to spend a period of studies or placement at “**Dunarea de Jos**” University of Galati for **Bachelor and Master Students** from the University of Sfax.

Mobility students will be awarded a scholarship, will attend courses and will use all the facilities of the “**Dunarea de Jos**” University of Galati on an equal basis as the enrolled students.

All passed exams previously approved in the **Learning Agreement**, will be recognised by the home institution (University of Sfax).

#### **CONDITIONS AND PROCEDURES**

*General conditions for admittance*

The candidate student must be enrolled at the University of Sfax that signed the Inter Institutional Agreement within the framework of Erasmus + Programme, with the **“Dunarea de Jos” University of Galati.**

The student must be **preselected** and **nominated** by the University of Sfax

## FUNDING

The grants offered to staff in the Erasmus+ Mobility between Programme and Partner Countries do not cover all the expenses, but are merely a contribution to bearing the additional cost of the stay abroad.

The grants include:

- A European Union **contribution for subsistence**: An amount established according to the country of destination and the actual number of days spent abroad. In particular, the grants are split into groups of countries according to the cost of living. the mobility contribution for Romania is **800 € per month** for students.
- An additional amount to cover **travel expenses**. The amount is calculated according to the distance band appearing below:

<b>Between 10 and 99 km:<sup>1i</sup></b>	20 EUR per participant
<b>Between 100 and 499 KM:</b>	180 EUR per participant
<b>Between 500 and 1999 KM:</b>	<b>275 EUR per participant</b>
<b>Between 2000 and 2999 KM:</b>	360 EUR per participant
<b>Between 3000 and 3999 KM:</b>	530 EUR per participant
<b>Between 4000 and 7999 KM:</b>	820 EUR per participant
<b>8000 KM or more:</b>	1500 EUR per participant

The distance will be calculated as follows: Distance between the city of the home University and **“DUNAREA DE JOS” UNIVERSITY OF GALATI.**

The **“DUNAREA DE JOS” UNIVERSITY OF GALATI** as Applicant organization will be in charge of the payment of the grants to the incoming scholarship holders once they have started their mobility in the **“DUNAREA DE JOS” UNIVERSITY OF GALATI** and have signed the Confirmation of Arrival and the Grant Agreement.

## APPLICATION PROCEDURES

For students:

- Copy of the Passport
- Knowledge of English (B2- Certificate)
- Transcript of Records (from the BAC)
- Short version of the research proposal (signed by the PhD student and the academic tutor)
- Short CV

<sup>1</sup> Based on the travel distance per participant. Travel distances must be calculated using the distance calculator supported by the European Commission ([http://ec.europa.eu/programmes/erasmus-plus/tools/distance\\_en.htm](http://ec.europa.eu/programmes/erasmus-plus/tools/distance_en.htm)). The distance of a one-way travel must be used to calculate the amount of the EU grant that will support the round trip.

- Motivation letter
- Certificate of enrolment
- Learning agreement signed by: Director of Studies or Head of Department

### Pre-selection criteria at the home university

The home university will provide a pre-selection of candidates according to the following general criteria:

- Average grade.
- The consistency of the proposed research activities.
- Language skills.
- Any other elements indicated by the student in the application (other learning experiences, specific academic interests, etc.).
- Additional criteria i.e: membership in science clubs or associations, participation in conferences and other mobility programmes etc. (it is up to the sending institution to include the criteria or not)
- Students who meet one or more of the following inclusion and diversity criteria established by the Erasmus+ program:
  - disability (i.e. participants with special needs): people with mental (intellectual, cognitive, learning), physical, sensory or other disabilities;
  - educational difficulties: young people with learning difficulties; early school-leavers; low qualified adults; young people with poor school performance.
  - economic obstacles: people with a low standard of living, low income, dependence on social welfare system or homeless; young people in long-term unemployment or poverty; people in debt or with financial problems.
  - cultural differences: immigrants or refugees or descendants from immigrant or refugee families; people belonging to a national or ethnic minority; people with linguistic adaptation and cultural inclusion difficulties.
  - health problems: people with chronic health problems, severe illnesses, or psychiatric conditions.
  - social obstacles: people facing discrimination because of gender, age, ethnicity, religion, sexual orientation, disability, etc.; people with limited social skills or anti-social or risky behaviors; people in a precarious situation; (ex-)offenders, (ex-)drug or alcohol abusers; young and/or single parents; orphans.
  - geographical obstacles: people from remote or rural areas; people living in small islands or in peripheral regions; people from urban problem zones; people from less serviced areas (limited public transport, poor facilities).
