

Call for Applications Staff mobility call

The Estonian University of Life Sciences (Estonia) in the framework of the European Programme ERASMUS+ KA1

Objective

The Erasmus+ Programme – mobility offers the possibility to spend a period of teaching/training at **Estonian University of Life Sciences** for **academic and administrative Staff** from the University of Sfax (Higher Institute of Biotechnology of Sfax)

The purpose of the activity is to share experiences in the field of Food processing and it will take place through an immersion in the different units of the **Estonian University of Life Sciences** on which the participant will discuss the points of common interest.

Financing

Grant amount: **120 € per day**.

Travel grant: **275 €**

All financial details will be duly described in the **Grant Agreement** that Staff will sign before their mobility starts.

Teaching Mobility:

Based on the budget allocated to the **Estonian University of Life Sciences**, it is possible to fund maximum 7 days (included travel days) per participant.

Conditions and procedures:

General conditions for admittance

Applications should be submitted to the home institution that will be responsible for selecting the participants, according to previously established criteria. All fundamental principles and mobility requirements set out in the Inter-Institutional Agreement must be respected. The selection procedure must be fair, transparent, coherent and documented and shall be made available to all parties involved in the selection process

- Invitation letter
- Application form (see annexIII)
- Teaching Agreement (see annex I) signed by home and receiving institutions
- Training Agreement (see annex II) signed by home and receiving institutions
